Backyard habitat designed for both family living and wildlife that features native trees and shrubs, native plant beds, raised edible beds and pesticide-free lawn. Bay-Wise certified.

Stone Barn Community Garden

3851 Park Mills Rd, Frederick, Md 21704

Forty community plots featuring fruit, vegetables, native flowers and compost tumblers. Landscape architect Joanne Carey will be available to answer questions.

Villages of Urbana Pollinator Garden
